PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

GENERAL: The information is provided pursuant to the Public Law 93-579 (Privacy Act of 1974), For DEA employees completing forms regarding Federal National Security Information clearance Periodic Reinvestigations.

AUTHORITY: E.O. 10450, E.O. 12356, 5 USC 1303 – 1305, 42 USC 2165 and 2455; 22 USC 2585 and 2519; and 5 USC 3301.

PURPOSES AND USES: Primarily for DEA internal use and is mandatory in accordance with the Federal Personnel Manual, Chapter 736, Section 1-7, which pertains to reinvestigations of incumbents holding critical-sensitive positions.

EFFECT: Failure to provide the necessary information could preclude employee's continued suitability to hold a critical-sensitive position.
